

RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 119

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT THE PROPOSAL RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO RFP #2011-19 TITLED “SPORTS OFFICIATING AND SCOREKEEPING SERVICES” AND RE-ADVERTISE SAID SOLICITATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF RECEIVING A WIDER ARRAY OF PROPOSALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral issued RFP #2011-12 titled “Sports Officiating and Scorekeeping Services” and received one (1) response by the September 27, 2011, 11:00 a.m. deadline; and

WHEREAS, Staff believes that there are various vendors that could provide the services as presented in this solicitation and who would undoubtedly be reached with additional advertising of the solicitation; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to reject the proposal received in response to RFP #2011-19 titled “Sports Officiating and Scorekeeping” and re-advertise said solicitation for the purposes of receiving a wider array of proposals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to reject the proposal received in response to RFP #2011-19 titled “Sports Officiating and Scorekeeping” and re-advertise said solicitation for the purposes of receiving a wider array of proposals.


