

RESOLUTION NO. 11- 28

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AS A MEMBER AGENCY OF THE CHILD ABDUCTION RESPONSE TEAM AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TO ADDRESS FORESEEABLE ROUTINE OR EMERGENCY SITUATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral has joined together with other law enforcement agencies in a multi-jurisdictional effort to rescue abducted children and, under circumstances, allocate their resources to missing/endangered children cases; and

WHEREAS, it is to the advantage of the City of Doral to receive and extend mutual aid in the form of law enforcement services and resources to adequately respond to continuing, multi-jurisdictional criminal activity, so as to protect the public peace and safety, and preserve the lives and property of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of Doral as a member agency of the Child Abduction Response Team and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement to address foreseeable routine or emergency situations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of Doral as a member agency of the Child Abduction Response Team and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement to address foreseeable routine or emergency situations.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
