A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REGISTER THE CITY OF DORAL IN THE LET'S MOVE! INITIATIVE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Let's Move! Cities, Towns and Counties ("LMCTC") is part of First Lady Michelle Obama's comprehensive Let's Move! Initiative; which is dedicated to reversing the childhood obesity epidemic within a generation; and

WHEREAS, the National League of Cities is providing technical assistance and tools to local elected officials who are participating in LMCTC and striving to build healthy communities; and

WHEREAS, cities participating in the Let's Move! Initiative can benefit by receiving national recognition, gain access to technical assistance from federal government and nonprofit sector experts, and participating in a national movement to build healthy communities for a healthy future; and

WHEREAS, participating communities are required to submit periodic progress reports on the five goals established by the initiative; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral already has existing programming including the Get Fit Doral program to promote the well-being and physical fitness of residents that meet the criteria established by the initiative for recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Authorization.</u> The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to register the City of Doral on behalf of the City Council in the Let's Move! initiative and submit periodic progress reports to the Let's Move! initiative as required.

Section 3. Goals. Once registered for the initiative, the City will commit to five achievable, measurable goals. The five goals are as follows:

- Start Early, Start Smart: Provide children in early care and education settings with a healthy start.
- 2. My Plate, Your Place: Display MyPlate in City-owned venues that serve food.
- Smart Servings for Students: Increase participation in school breakfast and lunch programs.
- 4. Model Food Service: Adopt healthy food service guidelines at Cityowned venues that serve food.
- 5. Active Kids at Play: Take steps to promote physical activity.

Section 4: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
