

RESOLUTION No. 18-157

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN GRAYBAR ELECTRICAL COMPANY, INC. AND THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI CONTRACT EV 2370 (THROUGH U.S. COMMUNITIES) FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS AND SPECIALIZED SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS “REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE – OTHER” ACCOUNT No. 001.80005.500460 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ANNUAL BUDGETED FUNDS FOR THESE SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AND TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the “City”) facilities are equipped with different electrical, lighting, data communications and security components. The different systems periodically need repairs, maintenance and upgrades to maintain all facilities to meet building energy efficiency standards; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Facilities Division is taking the first steps to upgrade all old lighting technology installed throughout the facilities to high efficiency LED technology; and

WHEREAS, these upgrades, that are in line with the Green Element Comprehensive Plan, will help to reduce the electrical consumption, reduce the monthly electrical utility bill, and reduce the constant maintenance and replacement of bulbs as the lifespan of LED technology is longer than the current installed technology; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (PWD) routinely procures repair services or purchases electrical and lighting materials from several vendors with no formal contract in place and each proposal is individually negotiated by the PWD staff on a case by case basis; and

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Department will benefit from the adoption of this contract as they currently purchase some Data Communications and Security components from Graybar; and

WHEREAS, the PWD respectfully request the City Council to authorize the City Manager to adopt the City of Kansas City, Missouri Contract No. EV 2370 (US Communities) in order to reduce the cost of any task associated with acquisition of materials, equipment, and services for electrical, lighting, data communications and security components.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Authorization. Pursuant to section 2-322 of the City Code of Ordinances, the City Manager is hereby authorized to adopt the existing agreement between Graybar Electrical Company, Inc. and the City of KANSAS CITY, Missouri Contract EV 2370 (through U.S. Communities) that was competitively bid, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the purchase of goods and specialized services on an as-needed basis in an amount not to exceed annual budgeted funds. Funds for these services were budgeted in the current fiscal year in the Public Works – "Repairs and Maintenance – Other" Account number 001.80005.500460 Electrical Contract Building/Lighting Repairs.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Rodriguez who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Mariaca and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
