RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 107

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF PROPERTY AND EVIDENCE STORAGE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$19,170.00 PER YEAR UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE FACILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department currently uses the property room of the Miami-Dade Police Department (MDPD) for property and evidence storage; and

WHEREAS, this facility is staffed on a 24-hour, 7-day basis and receives property from us not only for evidence but also for safe-keeping; and

WHEREAS, the MDPD has offered to extend this partnership until the City's new police facility is completed; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the MDPD for the provision of property and evidence storage in an amount not to exceed \$19,170.00 per year until the completion of the City of Doral police facility.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the MDPD for the provision of property and evidence storage in an amount not to exceed \$19,170.00 per year until the completion of the City of Doral police facility.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
