

RESOLUTION NO. 12-119

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,095,000.00 TO THE EXISTING AGREEMENT WITH LIMOUSINES OF SOUTH FLORIDA FOR A NEW TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$3,170,000.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF CONTINUED OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES OF THE EXPANDED DORAL TROLLEY SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral has an existing five (5) year contract dated December 1, 2008 with Limousines of South Florida for the operations and maintenance of the Doral Trolley System for a total contract amount of \$2,075,000.00; and

WHEREAS, since its inception, the operation and maintenance of the Doral Trolley System has expanded from one (1) vehicle to five (5) vehicles; and

WHEREAS, due to the additional operations and maintenance expenses for the added trolleys, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize an increase of \$1,095,000.00 to the existing agreement with Limousines of South Florida for a new total contract amount of \$3,170,000.00 for the provision of continued operation and maintenance services of the expanded Doral Trolley System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes an increase of \$1,095,000.00 to the existing agreement with Limousines of South Florida for a new total contract amount of \$3,170,000.00 for the provision of continued operation and maintenance services of the expanded Doral Trolley System.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


