

RESOLUTION NO. 04-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REQUEST THAT THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM NW 58TH STREET NORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST ALONG NW 107TH AVENUE FOR APPROXIMATELY 400 FEET BE POSTED "NO PARKING" AND TRANSMIT TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has noticed that there are trucks parked along the east side of NW 107th Avenue just north of NW 58th Street ; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes that the presence of these trucks in the public right-of-way pose a grave threat to the safety of its residents and commuters; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to promote safety throughout its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to request that the public right-of-way from NW 58th Street North, South, East and West along NW 107th Avenue, for approximately 400 feet, be posted "No Parking" and transmit to the Miami-Dade County Public Works Department.

Section 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Cabrera, who moved its adoption.


