

RESOLUTION No. 08 – 09

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PROCESS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN RENEWABLE ONE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION OF A RADIO FREQUENCY FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$329,538.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PROVISION OF SAME IN THE EVENT A RENEWABLE ONE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CANNOT BE NEGOTIATED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to provide for the immediate needs of the City of Doral police department to ensure quality and continuity of police service; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County Police Department is the current service provider of radio frequencies in the area ;

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that Council waive the Request for Proposals Process and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a renewable one-year agreement with Miami-Dade County for the provision of a radio frequency for the use of the City of Doral Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$329,538.00 consistent with Section 12 – 9 of the City of Doral Purchasing Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby waives the Request for Proposals process and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into renewable one (1)-year agreement with Miami-Dade County for the provision of a radio frequency for the use of the City of Doral Police Department in an amount not to

exceed \$329,538.00.

Section 2. In the event that a renewable one-year contract cannot be negotiated, the City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a three (3)- year with Miami-Dade County for the provision of a radio frequency for the use of the City of Doral Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$329,538.00 per year.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Ruiz and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
