

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE REAL-TIME OPERATIONS
CENTER/MULTI-AGENCY INTELLIGENCE NETWORK (M.A.I.N)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into between the City of Doral Police Department and the members of the Real-Time Operations Center (RTOC)/Multi-Agency Intelligence Network (M.A.I.N) to govern the formation, participation, and related cooperation of the members of the (M.A.I.N) Control Group.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the Parties, in consideration for mutual promises and covenants contained herein, agree to fully and faithfully abide by and be bound by the following terms and conditions:

I. OBJECTIVES

The overall objective of the RTOC/M.A.I.N is to assist the City of Doral Police Department, or his/her designee, in the RTOC/M.A.I.N with the exchange of criminal intelligence and/or data amongst investigators, detectives, and crime analysts.

In order to meet these objectives, the RTOC/M.A.I.N will address the following issues:

- Eligibility of Participating Agencies
- Information Submission Criteria
- Information Inquiry/Access/Dissemination Criteria
- Information Retention/Deletion Criteria
- Security of Information
- Audit Trails

2. COMPOSITION OF THE RTOC/M.A.I.N

The Doral Police Department will automatically serve as Lead Agency.

The RTOC/M.A.I.N is comprised of representatives from the following agencies:

- Medley Police Department
- Miami Springs Police Department
- Sweetwater Police Department
- Miami-Dade Police Department
- Virginia Gardens Police Department
- Hialeah Gardens Police Department
- Miami-Dade School Board Police Department
- Florida International University Police Department
- Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta (Miami Branch) Police Department
- United States Southern Command

3. APPLICABILITY

As a member of the RTOC/M.A.I.N, the undersigned agrees to comply with the provisions of the U.S. Department of Justice Criminal Intelligence Systems Operating Policies, 28 CFR Part 23 (September 16, 1993), and will not implement policies or procedures that conflict with the Regional Information Sharing Systems (RISS) Program Guidelines.

4. IMPLEMENTATION OF MOU

Members of the RTOC/M.A.I.N will serve as a working group, which will meet on a regular basis. The working group may, as appropriate, establish subcommittees comprised of other staff within the participating agencies to address special issues.

5. AUTHORITY

This MOU shall be carried out within the authority of the signing agencies.

6. AMENDMENTS


This MOU may be modified or amended by written agreement between the City of Doral Police Department and the members of the RTOC/M.A.I.N.

7. TERMINATION



RESOLUTION No. 21-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE REAL-TIME OPERATIONS CENTER MULTI-AGENCY INTELLIGENCE NETWORK TO ENSURE PUBLIC SAFETY BY PROVIDING ADEQUATE LEVELS OF POLICE SERVICES; PROVIDING IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the objective of the Real-Time Operations Center/Multi-Agency Intelligence Network (MAIN) is to assist the City of Doral Police Department, or his/her designee, in the Real-Time Operations Center/Multi-Agency Intelligence Network with the exchange of criminal intelligence and/or data amongst investigators, detectives, and crime analysts and other agencies; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council approve a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Doral Police Department and the Real-Time Operations Center/Multi-Agency Intelligence Network (MAIN) to ensure public safety by providing adequate levels of police services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Doral Police Department and the Real-Time Operations Center/Multi-Agency Intelligence Network (MAIN), attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference, is hereby approved. The City Manager is

hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the City subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


