

RESOLUTION No. 17-66

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND BCC ENGINEERING, INC., A PREQUALIFIED CITY VENDOR, FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS FOR THE NEW ROADWAY CONNECTION PROPOSED ALONG NW 112 AVENUE BETWEEN NW 34 STREET AND NW 41 STREET IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,105.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in further of the City Council's directive for an even further completed grid, the Public Works Department for the City of Doral (the "City") wishes to secure a firm to proceed with the cost-benefit analysis for the new proposed new roadway connection along NW 112th Avenue between NW 34th Street and NW 41st Street; and

WHEREAS, BCC Engineering, Inc. is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services, selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in December 2014, capable of providing the City with the foregoing analysis; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council approve a work order with BCC Engineering, Inc. in order to proceed with the benefit-cost analysis for the new proposed roadway connection of NW 112th Avenue between NW 34th Street and NW 41st Street; in an amount not to exceed \$54,105.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The Work Order between the City of Doral and BCC Engineering, Inc. for the provision of a benefit-cost analysis for the new roadway proposed on NW 112th Avenue between NW 34th Street and NW 41st Street; in an amount not to exceed \$54,105.00, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on the behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Fraga who moved its adoption.

The City of Doral authorizes the firm of BCC Engineering, Inc. to proceed with the provision of professional engineering services for the benefit-cost analysis for the new roadway connection proposed along NW 112th Avenue between NW 34th Street and NW 41st Street. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between BCC Engineering, Inc. and the City of Doral dated February 2, 2015, and the attached Proposal submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal dated March 21, 2017 from BCC Engineering, Inc. The schedule requires that the study be completed within one hundred and thirty five (135) calendar days. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a lump sum basis with a not to exceed amount of \$54,105.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal, and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated February 2, 2015 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply. This Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in three (3) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart be deemed an original Contract.
