

RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 105

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,000.00 FROM THE CITY OF DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT'S OPERATIONAL SUPPLIES (MUTUAL AID HOSTING) ACCOUNT FOR SPONSORSHIP OF THE CITIZENS' CRIME WATCH OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ANNUAL AWARDS CEREMONY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, for 36 consecutive years, the citizens' Crime Watch of Miami-Dade County has been committed to preventing and reducing crime in the community; and

WHEREAS, Citizens' Crime Watch is holding its' 36th Annual Awards Ceremony on September 23, 2011 at the DoubleTree Miami Airport and Convention Center; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the city manager to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00 from the City of Doral Police Department's Operational Supplies (Mutual Aid Hosting) account for sponsorship of the Citizens' Crime Watch of Miami-Dade County Annual Awards Ceremony.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00 from the City of Doral Police Department's Operational Supplies (Mutual Aid Hosting) account for sponsorship of the Citizens' Crime Watch of Miami-Dade County Annual Awards Ceremony.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


