ORDINANCE #2011-36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE CITY GENERAL FUNDS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Doral (the "City") believes that effective branding and wayfinding enhances experiences, attracts businesses and patrons, and contributes to a sense of place; and

WHEREAS, the area defined as the Doral Design District currently has no existing identity; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that implementing the Doral Design District Master Plan's adopted brand through vehicular signage at N.W. 36th Street and N.W. 25th Street on N.W. 79th Avenue is necessary to establish the identity of the Doral Design District; and

WHEREAS, City staff have estimated that the project will cost \$120,000, although the actual figure may need to be adjusted once actual proposals are received through the procurement process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to appropriate \$120,000 for the design and installation of appropriate signage, landscaping and lighting as per the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to adjust the City's General Funds Budget for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 (the "Budget") in order to reflect the \$120,000 expense for the signage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. <u>Budget Amendment</u>. In accordance with Article IV, Section 4.06 of the City Charter, the General Fund Budget is hereby amended and increased in the amount of \$120,000 by the inclusion of and appropriation to the following line item budget: Planning & Zoning Department – Capital Outlay Machinery and Equipment - Account 001.40005.500640: \$120,000. A supplemental appropriation is being made from the Contingent Reserve Fund – Account 001.50005.500492.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption on second reading.
