The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between EAC Consulting Inc. and the City of Doral dated January 4, 2021, and the attached Proposal dated June 22, 2022 and submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from EAC Consulting Inc. dated June 22, 2022 to provide "Post Design" services for ITB 2022-22 NW 58th Street Outfall Project (Sub Basin H-8 Drainage Phase 2-NW 58th Street Canal Outfall). The schedule requires the scoped of work to be completed within 240 Calendar Days of NTP. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and material basis not to exceed the amount of \$53,277.00.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated January 4, 2021 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply. Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

Pursuant to previous coordination efforts, EAC Consulting, Inc. (EAC) respectfully submits this professional services fee proposal to provide Construction Administration Support Services for the Basin H8 Drainage (Phase 2) NW 58 Street Canal Outfall project.

ITB Project Scope:

Advertised by the city as ITB 2022-22. the project encompasses the construction and installation of stormwater drainage improvements along NW 57th Street between NW 79th Avenue and NW 78th Avenue (Known as Phase I). In addition, project includes the construction and installation of a closed drainage system consisting of drainage piping interconnected within the basin to a proposed 48-inch diameter drainage outfall into the NW 58th Street Canal. Roadway restoration and milling & resurfacing is required for this project.

Construction Phase Duration:

180 calendar days

EAC Scope of Work

Our scope of work encompasses providing professional staff for construction administration support services to assist and support the city in implementing the construction of the requisite infrastructure improvements. We envision that this assignment will be inclusive of general administration tasks required to support city's personnel and city's designated CEI Consultant on an as need basis.

Our scope of work comprises of the following tasks:

- I. Update to Construction Cost Estimates
- II. Attendance at One Pre-Construction Meeting
- III. Construction Observations / Specialty Site Visits
- IV. Contractors' Submittals / Shop Drawings Reviews
- V. Design Clarification Responses / Request for Information (RFIs)
- VI. Field Orders, Change Order Requests and Claims
- VII. Construction Close Out Services
- VIII. As-Built Drawings Review

Specifically, our scope of work is described as follows:

I. Update to Construction Cost Estimates

EAC shall prepare updates to previously prepared Engineer's Estimate of Probable Construction costs based on current 6-month moving average unit prices for similar work.

II. Attendance at One Pre-Construction Meeting

EAC shall prepare for and attend one Pre-Construction meeting and provide answers regarding questions from the Contractor and Subcontractors. Participation in this task shall involve EAC's technical leads or designees. To derive level of effort (LOE) estimation, attendance at the Pre-Construction Meeting shall be assumed to by our

Project Manager and/or Senior Engineer and shall not include preparing presentations and any post meeting documentation.

III. Attendance at Construction Related Progress Meetings

Not Included in Scope of Work

IV. Construction Observations / Specialty Site Visits

EAC shall conduct site visit observations at bi-weekly intervals (for 6 months) corresponding to the various stages of construction to observe the progress and quality of the Work and to determine, in general, if the work is proceeding in accordance with the intent of the Contract Documents. For each site visit, our staff shall prepare Field Reports on the same date as the field visit occurs, to record the events that took place on the project site during the visit. To derive level of effort (LOE) estimation, each site visit shall be assumed at 6 hours per visit per person visiting the site and includes preparation and post visit documentation.

V. Contractors' Submittals / Shop Drawings Reviews

EAC staff shall review contractor submittals and/or shop drawings to determine conformance with the design concepts of the project and compliance with the requirements provided in the contract documents. All reviewed Contractor submittals shall bear EAC's review stamp and adequate notes or comments regarding the review(s) completed. The return of submittals shall be within two calendar weeks of receipt.

VI. Design Clarification Responses / Request for Information (RFIs)

EAC shall review and process all Requests for Information (RFI) developed by the Contractor to provide technical interpretation of the plans/drawings and specifications; shall evaluate requested deviation from the approved design or specification; shall review and respond to RFIs. EAC shall prepare supplementary sketches as may be necessary for clarification of construction plans and assist in resolving actual field conditions encountered by the Contractor. To derive level of effort (LOE) estimation, EAC anticipates a total of 12 RFIs.

VII. Field Orders, Change Order Requests and Claims

EAC shall review and evaluate requested deviations from the approved design drawings and/or specifications and offer opinion as necessary as requested by the City of Doral. EAC shall review all Contractor's change Order Requests and Claims and shall offer a recommendation of an appropriate cost and course of action. For purposes of estimation, EAC shall assume a total of 40 staff hours for this task.

If additional hours are required due to circumstances beyond EAC's control, EAC shall notify the city accordingly, and submit a request for additional services/compensation.

VIII. Construction Close Out Services

EAC shall conduct close out visits to the project to inspect the project to determine if the project is completed in general conformance of the construction contract documents.

- 1. Substantial Completion and Final Completion: EAC shall attend and inspect the constructed work. EAC shall coordinate with the City of Doral representatives in verifying the completion of the construction contract and assist the City of Doral with developing Substantial and Final Punch Lists.
- 2. Permit Close-out Services: EAC shall perform services to close-out and provided appropriate certifications and clearances to permitting and jurisdictional agencies

IX. As-Built Drawings Review

This scope of work assumes that the Contractor shall be responsible for preparing, updating, and maintaining asbuilt drawing documentation. EAC shall review as-built drawings submitted by the contractor and provide comments to the contractor for revision(s) as necessary. Once the as-builts are considered satisfactory by EAC, we shall provide a letter to the City certifying the completion of the as-built drawings.

If additional hours are required due to circumstances beyond EAC's control, EAC shall notify the city accordingly, and submit a request for additional services/compensation.

IX. Record Drawings

Not Included in Scope of Work

EAC proposes to provide the scope of services (described above) in the amount of \$ 53,277 as itemized in our fee computation template (Attachment No. 1). Invoices will be submitted monthly.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A WORK ORDER WITH EAC CONSULTING, INC. TO PROVIDE POST DESIGN SERVICES FOR ITB 2022-22 NW 58 STREET OUTFALL PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$53,277.00; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2021, the 2021 Stormwater Master Plan and the proposed 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) was adopted by the City Council via Resolution No. 21-123 (approved 5-0); and

WHEREAS, the results of the Stormwater Master Plan analysis allowed the City

to identify and prioritize general areas where major drainage systems are deficient and define the extent of the deficiencies; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (PWD) requested a proposal from EAC

Consulting, Inc. (EAC) to provide Post Design Services for ITB 2022-22 NW 58th Street Outfall; and

WHEREAS, the 48-inch outfall will service Sub Basin H-5 which is located between NW 79th Avenue and NW 77th Court from NW 56th Street to NW 52nd Street. The outfall will discharge into the NW 58th Street Canal from the vicinity of the NW 58th Street and NW 79th Avenue intersection; and

WHEREAS, EAC is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in December 2020 via Resolution 20-243; and

WHEREAS, the work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between EAC and the City of Doral dated January 4, 2021, and the attached Proposal dated June 22, 2022; and

WHEREAS, staff respectfully requests authorization for the City Manager to execute Work Order No. 6 to EAC to provide Post Design Services for ITB 2022-22 NW 58th Street Outfall project in an amount not to exceed \$53,277.00, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Funding for this request is available in the current Fiscal Year in the Public Works Stormwater Fund – "Construction in Progress" Account, Account No. 401.80005.500650.
