

**RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 84**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF MEDLEY FOR THE USE OF THE MEDLEY POLICE FIREARMS TRAINING CENTER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Doral Police Department seeks a Hold Harmless Agreement between the City of Doral and the Town of Medley to obtain the use of facilities operated and maintained by the Town of Medley for the purpose of conducting firearms and other related training; and

**WHEREAS,** Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a Hold Harmless Agreement with the Town of Medley for the use of the Medley Police Firearms Training Center.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into a Hold Harmless Agreement with the Town of Medley for the use of the Medley Police Firearms Training Center.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
