RESOLUTION No. 17-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-321 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID PROCESS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE TYLER MUNIS CASHIERING AND ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE SOFTWARE; APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF SAME IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$49,185.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO **ENTER** INTO AGREEMENT AND **EXPEND** TO BUDGETED **FUNDS** FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral ("the City") uses Tyler Technologies/ Munis software for its financial software program; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies/ Cashiering software will increase efficiencies related to the cashiering system in the City; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies/ Cashiering software facilitates processing over the counter permit payments by integrating with CD Permit Plus. Which will save the city critical time and resources; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-321 of the City Code of Ordinances (the "Code") provides that the City Council may, by majority vote, waive the City's competitive bidding procedures, upon the recommendation of the city manager that it is in the best interest to do so considering such factors as the nature of the goods or services;

WHEREAS, the City manager has recommended the waiver of the competitive bidding process for the purchase of the Tyler Technologies/Cashiering software because it is a module for our current software platform, which directly "plugs-into" the City's current software platform without the need for the City to incur any integration and retraining cots; ad

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to purchase the Tyler Technologies/ Cashiering software in an amount not to exceed \$49,185.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Waiver.</u> Pursuant to section 2-321 of the City Code, and upon the recommendation of the City Manager, the competitive bid process is hereby waived for the purchase of the Tyler Technologies/ Cashiering software.

Section 3. Approval & Authorization. The purchase of the Tyler Technologies/
Cashiering software in an amount not to exceed \$49,185.00 is hereby approved. The
City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
