

RESOLUTION No. 16-218

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARDED INVITATION TO BID #2016-18, "NW 92 AVENUE ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION FROM NW 27 STREET TO NW 33 STREET," TO ACOSTA TRACTOR, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ACOSTA TRACTOR, INC., SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE CITY ATTORNEY AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY FOR THE ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AT NW 92 AVENUE FROM NW 27 STREET TO NW 33 STREET, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,548,924.36, AND TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") issued Invitation To Bid #2016-18, NW 92 Avenue Roadway Construction From NW 27 Street To NW 33 Street (the "ITB"), on August 1, 2016 for the purpose of providing labor & materials to construct the Roadway Improvements as specified at NW 92 Avenue from NW 27 Street to NW 33 Street (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, three (3) firms attended the non-mandatory pre-bid meeting held on August 16, 2016 and nine (9) submittals were received and opened on September 9, 2016, with only one (1) firm not meeting the required criteria; and

WHEREAS, Acosta Tractor, Inc. was found to be the Lowest most Responsible and Responsive Bidder. A copy of Acosta Tractor's bid is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Bid"), which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

WHEREAS, staff has recommended the Mayor and City Council award the ITB to Acosta Tractors and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Acosta Tractors for the provision of construction services for the Project, in an

amount not to exceed \$1,548,924.36 and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Award. The ITB is hereby awarded to Acosta Tractors, Inc., the lowest, most responsive and responsible firm, in accordance with the same or substantially similar terms of its Bid. This award does not, in and of itself, confer any contractual rights on Acosta Tractors, Inc.

Section 3. Authorization to Procure Services. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate with Acosta Tractor, Inc., as the top ranked firm, and enter into an agreement, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency for the provision of construction services for the Project, in an amount of not to exceed \$1,548,924.36 which includes a ten percent (10%) contingency, and to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.


Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cabrera and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


