

**RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 87**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FL RETROACTIVELY APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR THE FY 2011 EDWARD BYRNE JAG – LOCAL SOLICITATION GRANT IN A GRANT AMOUNT OF \$11,417.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Doral Police Department has been allocated \$11,417.00 by the Fiscal Year 2011 Edward Byrne JAG – Local Solicitation Grant to be used to purchase a T3 Personal Mobility Vehicle for the use of police officers in areas where traditional patrol vehicles cannot be used; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to receive the grant funds, an application needs to be submitted; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council retroactively approve the application for the Fiscal Year 2011 Edward Byrne JAG – Local Solicitation Grant in a grant amount of \$11,417.00.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**
