A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE LAUNCH OF THE VETERANS PARK BRICK CAMPAIGN; IDENTIFYING THE FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION AS THE OFFICIAL BENEFICIARY OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE BRICK CAMPAIGN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Doral is launching a brick campaign at Veterans Park to be able to donate funds to a foundation benefitting Veterans and the military; and

WHEREAS, upon extensive research, the Fisher House Foundation is a good candidate to be a beneficiary of said funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral has supported the Fisher House Foundation in the past through events like the 4th of July celebration and their honorable efforts were mentioned at the opening of Veterans Park in November 2010; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City of Doral authorize the City Manager to proceed with the launch of the Veterans Park Brick Campaign and identify the Fisher House Foundation as the official beneficiary of funds received from the Brick Campaign.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to proceed with the launch of the Veterans Park Brick Campaign and identify the Fisher House Foundation as the official beneficiary of funds received from the Brick Campaign.
