

RESOLUTION No. 08 – 129

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE EXPANSION OF THE HIGH SPEED DATA NETWORK FROM AT&T FOR THE PROVISION OF EXTENDED SERVICE TO DORAL PARK AND DORAL MEADOW PARK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$23,800.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral currently leases a high speed data network between City Hall, the Police Operations Center (OPS), and the NAP of the Americas from AT&T; and

WHEREAS, funding for the expansion of the network to include Doral Park and Doral Meadow Park was approved in the FY 08-09 budget; and

WHEREAS, this investment will allow the City parks to be an integral part of the City's network so that the public will have access to electronic services such as credit card and check payments for programs and rentals; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the expansion of the High Speed Data Network from AT&T for the provision of extended service to Doral Park and Doral Meadow Park in an amount not to exceed \$23,800.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the expansion of the High Speed Data Network from AT&T for the provision of extended service to Doral Park and Doral Meadow Park in an amount not to exceed \$23,800.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Councilman Van Name who moved its adoption.
