

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-110**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE ONE (1) SKYWATCH TOWER FROM FLIR INTEGRATED SOLUTIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$137,000.00; RECOGNIZING THAT THIS PURCHASE AGREEMENT IS BASED ON AN EXISTING FEDERAL GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, OF THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Doral Police Department seeks to purchase one SkyWatch tower to promote crime prevention efforts at City of Doral special events and in the business community throughout the year; and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase would be made using the L.E.T.F. (Forfeiture Fund Expenditures) account from FLIR Integrated Solutions, a City of Doral registered vendor; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to section 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to purchase one (1) SkyWatch tower from FLIR Integrated Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$137,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff further requests that this purchase agreement be based on an existing Federal General Services Administration Agreement which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City Manager to purchase one (1) SkyWatch tower from FLIR Integrated Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$137,000.00.

**Section 2.** The City Council further recognizes that this purchase agreement is based on an existing Federal General Services Administration Agreement which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor DiPietro who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman Boria and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
