

RESOLUTION No.15-147

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE AWARD OF THE INVITATION TO BID #2015-20 “PALO ALTO SECURITY APPLIANCES” TO CHAMPION SOLUTIONS GROUP; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHAMPION SOLUTIONS GROUP, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE CITY ATTORNEY, FOR THE PURCHASE AND BASIC CONFIGURATION, INCLUDING RACK CONFIGURATION OF CERTAIN PALO ALTO DEVICES, AND PREPAID MAINTENANCE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$116,769.40 (\$57,500.00 FOR FY 2014-2015 AND \$59,269.40 FOR FY 2015-2016); PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2015, the City of Doral (the “City”) issued Invitation to Bid #2015-20 for “Palo Alto Security Appliances” (the “ITB”) for the purchase of certain equipment, configuration service and maintenance services for the City’s information technology infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, in response to the ITB, one (1) firm attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting held on July 9, 2015 and the City received one (1) submittal from Champions Solutions Group (“CSG”) by the advertised deadline; and

WHEREAS, CSG was found to be a responsible and responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into agreement with CSG to provide the City with Palo Alto Security Appliances, including four (4) 3020 firewalls (two (2) to be installed in FY 2014-2015 and two (2) in FY 2015-2016), basic configuration, including rack configuration, and three (3) years of prepaid maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$116,769.40 (\$57,500.00 FY 2014-2015 and \$59,269.40 FY 2015-2016).

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval of Award. The award of the Invitation to Bid #2015-20 “Palo Alto Security Appliances” is hereby awarded to Champion Solutions Group, subject to the entering into an agreement with the City on the same or substantially similar terms as presented in CSG’s submittal. The award of the ITB does not in and of itself constitute a vested contractual right to CSG.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute such agreements and other contractual documents, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency, as may be necessary to procure Palo Alto Security Appliances, including four (4) 3020 firewalls (two (2) to be installed in FY 2014-2015 and two (2) in FY 2015-2016), basic configuration, including rack configuration, and three (3) years of prepaid maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$116,769.40 (\$57,500.00 FY 2014-2015 and \$59,269.40 FY 2015-2016). The City Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Fraga who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Ruiz and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
