A portion of this activity (4,100 square feet) is located in the 100-year floodplain type (AH-8). The proposed project is located at 800 SW 107th Avenue, Miami, FL 33199. The purpose of Florida International University Engineering Building project is for a PET Cyclotron facility including support lab and infrastructure spaces. The new laboratory will allow the university to perform imaging studies on several diseases particularly prevalent in the community. The project is located on the ground level of the new FIU College of Engineering Building BT-919.

There are three primary purposes for this notice. First, people who may be affected by activities in floodplains and those who have an interest in the protection of the natural environment should be given an opportunity to express their concerns and provide information about these areas. Second, an adequate public notice program can be an important public educational tool. The dissemination of information about floodplains can facilitate and enhance Federal efforts to reduce the risks associated with the occupancy and modification of these areas. Third, as a matter of fairness, when the Federal government determines it will participate in actions taking place in floodplains, it must inform those who may be put at greater or continued risk.
