## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that **on Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.** the City of Doral Council will hold a **VIRTUAL COUNCIL MEETING** with the elected officials, administration and City staff participating via video conferencing.

Governor DeSantis' Executive Order Number 20-69 and Extension 20-246 suspended the requirements of Section 112.286, Florida Statutes and the Florida Sunshine Law, that a quorum to be present in person, and that a local government body meet at a specific public place. The Executive Order also allows local government bodies to utilize communications media technology, such as telephonic and video conferencing for local government body meetings.

<u>Public Comments:</u> members of the public that wish to provide comments may do so by emailing the City Clerk at <u>cityclerk@cityofdoral.com</u>. Comments must be submitted with your name and full address by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>October 13</u>, <u>2020</u>. The comments will be circulated to the elected officials and administration, as well as remain as a part of the record for the meeting.

The meeting will be broadcasted live for members of the public to view on the City of Doral's website (<a href="https://www.cityofdoral.com/government/city-clerk/council-meetings">https://www.cityofdoral.com/government/city-clerk/council-meetings</a>) as well as Channel 77 and Facebook Live.

If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Council with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, that person will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
