

RESOLUTION NO. 10-147

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MITIGATION BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$38,279.00 AS PART OF PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FROM THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT (DERM) FOR TREE REMOVAL IN THE NEW DORAL POLICE STATION SITE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral applied to the Miami-Dade County Department of Environmental Resources Management (DERM) for a tree removal permit for the new Doral police station site; and

WHEREAS, prior to issuing the tree removal permit, DERM has required the City to provide a mitigation bond in the amount of \$38,279.00 for the removal of a majority of the trees from said site; and

WHEREAS, the bond will be returned to the City upon planting of the trees required to mitigate any lost canopy; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute a mitigation bond in the amount of \$38,279.00 as part of permit requirements by DERM for tree removal in the new Doral police station site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a mitigation bond in the amount of \$38,279.00 as part of permit requirements by DERM for tree removal in the new Doral police station site.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
