A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE EXISTING AGREEMENT WITH RECREATIONAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF CONTINUED PHASE ONE DEVELOPMENT AT J.C. BERMUDEZ PARK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$298,999.38; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral has an existing agreement with Recreational Design and Construction, Inc. (RDC) for design and construction services for JC Bermudez Park Phase One development; and

WHEREAS, during the design and permitting process, it was determined that wetlands existed on the site and permits would not be issued until mitigation was resolved; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral was able to reach a mitigation settlement with the permitting agencies which resulted in a \$298,999.38 Hole-in-the-Donut Mitigation Credit Payment and Staff respectfully requests that the City Council approve a change order to the existing agreement with RDC for the provision of continued Phase I development at J.C. Bermudez Park in an amount not to exceed \$298,999.38.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves a change order to the existing agreement with RDC for the provision of continued Phase I development at J.C. Bermudez Park in an amount not to exceed \$298,999.38.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
