Subject: First Day of School Maintenance of Traffic Updates

The purpose of this Letter to Council (LTC) is to provide information for the Mayor and City Council regarding the current projects Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) permits adjacent to schools within the City of Doral.

Please be advised that in efforts to curb traffic congestion during the first day of school tomorrow, the Public Works Department has instructed the on-going projects adjacent to schools to withhold MOT set up until 10:00 A.M. or avoid construction on this day in its entirety.

The developer has MOT permits with the County for these areas.
