



Electrical Vehicle Charging Station Permit Requirement

BD-54 v1 26/07

Important Notice: The City of Doral requires a permit for the installation of an electrical vehicle charging station. This requirement helps ensure that all electrical work is completed safely, properly, and in compliance with applicable codes and regulations.

Why is a permit required?

Electrical panel capacity review, circuit installation, and other safety-related work. The permit process allows the City to verify that the installation meets code requirements and is completed by properly licensed professionals.

When is a permit required?

A permit is required before installing, replacing, or modifying an electrical charging station, including chargers installed at residential, commercial, or multi-family properties.



What may be required?

The following may be required as part of the permit submittal:

- A completed permit application
- A licensed electrical contractor
- Electrical plans including electrical load calculations, circuit number, charger location and installation specifications (FBC 107.3.5)
- Charger manufacturer information
- Any additional documents requested during plan review

Important Reminder

Work may not begin until the permit has been reviewed, approved, and issued by the City of Doral Building Department. Starting work without an issued permit may result in delays, corrections, penalties, or additional requirements.

Inspections

After installation, required inspections must be scheduled and approved before the charging station is placed into service. This ensures the installation was completed according to the approved permit and applicable electrical codes.
