WINDOW & DOOR REPLACEMENT INSPECTION PROCEDURES

BDI Window/Door Framing inspection (Inspection Code 1150) is required pursuant to the Florida Building Code, *Building*, Section 110.3.

In the event this inspection is not requested, and the work is concealed, the Building Official or designee will indicate one or more openings to be removed for anchor and substrate verification.

<u>The Contractor</u> will be responsible for removing and re-installing any window/door requested to be removed by the inspector in order to perform the inspection.

If the unconcealed work complies with the approved plans and the Florida Building Code, a letter of certification from the Architect or Engineer can be submitted for the remaining concealed work.

If the unconcealed work does not comply with the approved plans and the Florida Building Code, <u>all concealed work must be exposed</u> for inspection by the City of Doral Building Department.

BDI Building Final (Inspection Code 1044) shall be performed when window/door installation is complete, and the framing inspection is approved. This inspection will close the BD Windows/Door (Primary) permit.

All labels/stickers must remain on the windows and doors for this inspection.

PLEASE NOTE: Pictures will **NOT** be accepted as a substitute for required inspections.
