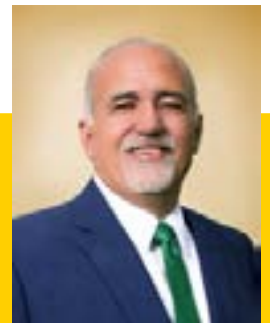

With 250 corporate headquarters and 100 multinational corporations, Doral means business. Accreditation / Professional Compliance



Doral Police Department Accreditation:

On October 7, 2021, the City of Doral Police Department was awarded with its second Law Enforcement Rec accreditation Certificate by the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFLA). Accreditation signifies that Doral Police Department has met specific standards of excellence and operates according to norms established by professional law enforcement practitioners.

The Police Department reaccreditation process began on August 3rd, 2018, under the direction and leadership of the now Interim City Manager Hernan Organvidez and Interim Chief of Police Raul M. Ubieta to improve police services for the community and the quality of life for our residents and individuals who commute through the city.

The Police Department's Accreditation Team, which included Accreditation Lieutenant Samika Gibson, Accreditation Manager Nadine Alphonse, Sergeant Michael Witherspoon, and Sergeant Nilsa Mercado dedicated 100% of their time to ensure that the entire police department complied with Accreditation Standards. The Department compliance entailed addressing departmental training and revising policies and procedures to improve the departments effectiveness with laws and the accreditation standards.

On August 03, 2021, CFLA assessors arrived at the Police Department and were given corte blanche access to the Police Department. CFLA assessors spent three days dissecting the department's policies, procedures, and way of doing business. Policies were compared to CFLA standards and proofs of compliance were examined. Employees were interviewed about their jobs, responsibilities, and knowledge of policies.

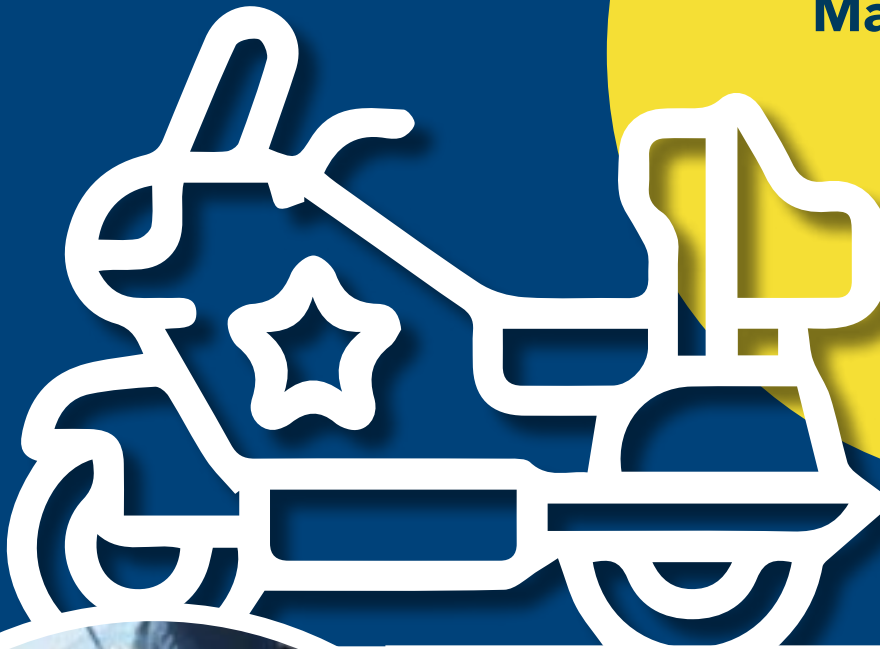
After three grueling days of inspection, the assessors found no compliance issues and left commending the Doral Police Department stating, "the agency showed immense professionalism through the accreditation review...". The assessors were impressed by the employees that were interview throughout the process. Every person they spoke with presented himself/herself as a professional, knowledgeable in his/her assigned task.

The School resource Officers (SROs) accomplish this by being proactive and community driven. Officers teach a number of programs such as D.A.R.E., anti-bullying, drug awareness, and safe driving.

Police Service Aide Academy



The Police Service Aide Academy Training is a limited admittance academy. The Police Service Aide Academy will prepare applicants for employment as Community Service Officers, Traffic Crash Investigators, and Parking Enforcement Specialists in accordance with Chapters 316.640 and 943, Florida Statute.

Courses topics include but are not limited to Criminal Law, Constitutional Law, Parking Enforcement, Traffic Crash Investigation, First Aid, Vehicle Operation, Radio Communications,

Report Writing, Traffic Control, Ethics, Crime Scene Investigation and much more. Simulated activities and applied skills compliment the classroom instruction.

In accordance with State Law, a student must pass the academy with a score of 80 percent to successfully complete the Academy. This is a highly structured and disciplined program. Applicants must maintain excellent attendance and cannot miss more than 10 percent of scheduled class sessions.

The Training Unit is responsible for planning, revising, implementing evaluating, and updating training programs to ensure that all training is job related and conforms to current law and Departmental directives. The Training Unit coordinates, develop, and implement training for all department personnel, sworn and civilian. This involves certification courses, specialty courses, annual in-service and recertification training, and working with other units to assist with requested or identified training needs. The Training Unit appropriately documents, enhances the knowledge, skills, and abilities of Department personnel necessary for performing their duties concurrent with current law enforcement practice.

Training is an important component to providing quality law enforcement services to the community. Training should be consistent with the Department's mission and values as well as goals and objectives

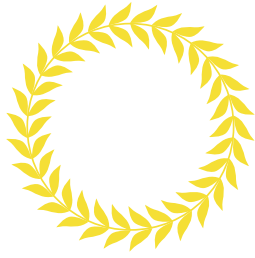
