- 1. You mentioned the schedule would be considered non-responsive. How is that to be considered in the LOI.
  - The schedule is part of the evaluation criteria for Phase II. Please refer to the RFP for evaluation criteria.
- 2. Three firms submitted for the previous solicitation. One was disqualified. Why did the City cancelled the solicitation rather than moving froward with two proposals?
  - It was in the best interest of the City to cancel the previous solicitation and readvertised.
- 3. Also, in the event less than two firms submit for this solicitation, will it be cancelled?
  - The City will make a decision in compliance with FDOT guidelines once proposals are received.
- 4. What will be FDOT's role in the procurement/construction management of the project?
  - As a LAP project, FDOT is involved throughout the design phase for all approvals of design as well as being involved throughout the construction phase for adherence to FDOT and LAP guidelines.
- 5. Can the LOI be sent electronically, or does it need to be physically turned in? If electronic, what are the electronic size limitations by email?
  - Letters of Interest must be uploaded to either DemandStar or Vendor Registry.
- 6. Do the FDOT specifications govern the construction requirements?
  - Yes, FDOT and LAP standards and criteria will govern this project.
- 7. Will DemandStar applies for this new advertisement?
  - Letters of Interest must be uploaded to either DemandStar or Vendor Registry.
- 8. Can the Prime Consultant make the electronic submittal of the LOI, as they have access to DemandStar?
