Addendum No. 3

This Addendum is and does become a part of the above-mentioned solicitation. This addendum is issued to modify the subject solicitation as follows:

1. Can the City please clarify how it will assess the criteria for "Successful legal defenses" which constitutes 10 points in the RFP? For example, will it include assessments of Tabs 3 and 5 related to litigation filed against proposers (Tab 5), as well as contracts terminated in the past three years (Tab 3). If those Tabs / Disclosures are not included in the legal defenses category, how will they be evaluated and what impact on the score will they have?

For reference:

Tab 3: "Additionally, Proposer shall list any contracts or agreements terminated for convenience, cause, or default within the past three (3) years and shall provide an explanation of each occurrence (if any). If no occurrences, Proposer shall so indicate."

Tab 5: "Provide a summary of any litigation filed against the proposer in the past three years that is related to the services that proposer provides in the regular course of business. The summary shall state the nature of the litigation, a brief description of the case, the outcome or projected outcome, and the monetary amount involved."

- Yes, the City will assess responses provide in both Tabs 3 and 5 in order to determine 'Successful legal defense' in response to litigation brought against the proposing firm. Tab 3 – will factor both the second and third bullets as highlighted below. Tab 5 - The City's intent is to ensure that the proposing entity has acted properly when it issued tickets. If a firm has not been sued based on malicious practices, they will need to affirm this within their proposal.
 - Proposers shall also provide a summary statement regarding any legal charges and/or convictions of the organization or its officers regarding fraud, bribery, or criminal offenses. Specific legal matters and law suits within the last five (5) years.
 - Additionally, Proposer shall list any contracts or agreements terminated for convenience, cause, or default within the past three (3) years and shall provide an explanation of each occurrence (if any). If no occurrences, Proposer shall so indicate.
