

## City of Doral RFP No. 2024 - 08 Landscape and Athletic Fields Maintenance Addendum No. 3

Please note the following changes to the schedule for the above-referenced solicitation (stricken words are deleted and underlined words are added):

## Please note the following questions received by the City and their respective answers:

1. Regarding Doral Central Price sheet section 2.: On the Bermuda, it only states mowing and fertility however, there is no mention of weed management, aeration or other cultural services. The same service required for the ball fields should be included on this property.

Answer: Yes, an updated price sheet was uploaded on June 6, 2024, for the Bermuda grass at Doral Central Park, which includes annual weed control, insect, aerating and top dressing.

2. When does the City anticipate commencing services under the contract, if awarded?

Answer: October/ November

3. When is Phase IV of Doral Central Park expected to be completed by the existing contractor?

Answer: December/January

4. Will the City separately price Phase IV of Doral Central Park?

Answer: No, we expect it to be included in Group 1 of Doral Central Park

5. Does Group 1 price sheet include the Doral Central Park multi-purpose field which is also listed in Group 2?

Answer: No, the Bermuda Grass Multipurpose field is listed separately in Group 2

6. Will the trees located on the Doral Central Park multi-purpose field be managed by the vendor(s) selected for Group 1 or Group 2?

Answer: Trees are part of Group 1

7. Will the City consider an extension of the questions deadline and submission deadline?

Answer: The deadlines have been extended. Please see updated schedule above.

8. Are Landscape design documents available for Doral Central Park?

Answer: Yes, the landscape design documents are attached to this Addendum.

9. Will the Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustments impact the contract annually or on a different schedule? If different, please specify the adjustment frequency and criteria.

Answer: Prices proposed shall remain fixed for at least two (2) years. Thereafter, pricing may increase on an annual basis based on CPI.

10. Does the City have a capital improvement plan for parks that could influence turf renovations and landscape improvements?

Answer: Yes, but not for FY 24/25

11. Could the city provide boundary maps for all of the properties listed in the RFP?

Answer: For the bikeways and trails, please refer to Exhibit C of this RFP. For all other parks, the scope of work is confined within the fenced area of the park grounds, except for Doral Central Park (east side), where the landscaped area extends beyond the fence to the sidewalk on 87th Avenue, following the park's fence perimeter. Landscape drawings for Doral Central Park are attached to this Addendum.

12. Is there a tree and palm count per park?

Answer: No

13. Are there landscape plans or renderings for Doral central Park under construction?

Answer: Yes, please see landscape drawings attached hereto.

14. When is Central Park going to be ready for Maintenance? How many phases?

Answer: Two phases October/ November and December/January

15. Is the new landscape at Central Park under warranty and maintenance, if so for how long?

Answer: The warranty for Doral Central Park is for approximately two (2) years, commencing from the date of substantial completion.

16. What is the budget for the upcoming fiscal year for all sites?

Answer: The budget for the next fiscal year has not been finalized.

17. What is the current bill rate for each line item for each park listed in the excel price sheet?

Answer: A copy of the existing vendors' pricing sheet may be provided pursuant to a records request to procurement@cityofdoral.com.

18. Page 17 states it's the City's intent to select 1 or 2 contractors. Can we provide 2 pricing options? (1 if awarded all together and 1 if split into 2 contracts)

Answer: Pricing must be as indicated in the pricing sheet. The City will not accept alternate proposals.

19. If the City selects 2 contractors to perform the work, how will the City split the contract?

Answer: Please refer to Section 2.11 Basis of Award.

20. Is there a performance bond requirement? If so, what %?

Answer: No

21. Is there a bid bond requirement? If so, what %?

Answer: No

22. Will contractor be permitted to increase rate according to CPI in the optional renewal year terms?

Answer: Please see answer to question no. 9 above.

24. Who is responsible for emptying the litter receptacles at parks?



Answer: Please refer to the scope specified in the RFP, which includes the addition of Doral Central Park.


