ARTICLE 3 - SCOPE OF WORK / TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 Purpose and Intent

The City of Doral is seeking sealed bids from qualified Contractors for all material, labor, equipment and services to accomplish the Stormwater Improvements to Sub-Basin D-3-1 at NW 29th Street and NW 79th Avenue work, as more particularly described in this ITB.

3.2 Scope of Work

The Stormwater Improvements to Sub-Basin D-3-1 at NW 29th Street and NW 79th Avenue work generally entails the installation of inlet protection, maintenance of traffic (MOT), asphalt concrete, storm drain inlets, concrete manholes, pipe culvert, french drain systems, concrete curbing, temporary painted paving markings, thermoplastic paving markings, related demolition of existing structures and milling of existing roadway surface as per approved S&S Plans provide by Dillon James Swiderski Soto, P.E. of 300 Engineering Group, L.L.C, dated 5/14/2024, all of which is attached hereto as composite Exhibit E.

The City reserves the right to utilize any combination of the base bid, add alternates as they so desire to achieve the proper balance between the required improvements, desired improvements, and the City's available project budget. The City reserves the right to request per unit/each pricing of materials listed on the bid form for clarification or to purchase additional materials.

3.3 Qualifications

For Contractors to be considered, Contractors must submit with their bid evidence that they have sufficient experience and are qualified to satisfactorily perform the work required by this Solicitation and at the City's sole discretion.

- Provide a detailed description of at least three (3) projects similar in detail to the Project's Scope of Work described in these Solicitation Documents and in which the Bidder's identified personnel are currently engaged or has completed within the past five (5) years.
- Provide evidence of the successful completion of at least three (3) roadway and stormwater improvement projects of at least half a million dollars (\$500,000) each in construction costs performed in Miami-Dade County or Broward County within the last five (5) years.
- List and describe the aforementioned projects and state whether the work was performed for specific government clients, or private entities.

The description must identify each project:

- The identified personnel and their assigned role and responsibilities for the listed project.
- The client's name and address including a contact person and phone number for reference,
- Description of work,
- Total dollar value of the contract,
- Contract duration,
- Statement or notation of whether Bidder's referenced personnel is/was employed by the prime contractor or subcontractor thru project completion,
- Provide letters of certification of final acceptance or similar project closeout documentation issued by the client and or available Contractor's performance evaluations.

The City reserves the right to request additional information and/or contact listed persons pertaining to bidder's experience.
