PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE PROVIDER REGISTRATION

A Communications Services Provider that desires to place, maintain, or occupy the City of Doral's public right-of-way to deliver Communications Services is required to register with the Public Works Department. **No public right-of-way construction permit will be issued to a Communications Services Provider not registered with the City of Doral (as per City of Doral Ordinance Chapter 38, Article II, Communications Right of Way).**

To obtain a Communications Services Provider registration from the City, the following requirements must be met:

- **Insurance Requirements:**
 - Workers compensation and employer's liability insurance as required by Florida Statute **(as per Florida Statute Chapter 337.401, Use of right-of-way for utilities subject to regulation; permit; fees).**
 - Comprehensive General liability bodily injury and property damage: \$3,000,000.00 combined single limit each occurrence **(as per City of Doral Ordinance Chapter 38, Article II, Communications Right of Way).**
 - Business automobile liability bodily injury and property damage: \$3,000,000.00 combined single limit each occurrence **(as per City of Doral Ordinance Chapter 38, Article II, Communications Right of Way).**
- **Restoration Bond:**

Prior to performing any permitted work in the public rights-of-way, the city shall require the registrant to establish in the City's favor a restoration bond to secure the restoration of the public right -of-way and to ensure the registrant's faithful performance of the restoration of the public rights-of-way once the construction is complete.
- **Registration Renewal:**

A registrant shall renew its registration pursuant to Florida Statute Chapter 337. Failure to renew a registration may result in the City restricting the issuance of additional permits until the communications services provided has met all renewal requirements. **(as per City of Doral Ordinance Chapter 38, Article II, Communications Right of Way).**
- **Other requirements:**

The registrant is required to provide a copy of the registrant's current certificate of authorization issued by the Florida Public Service Commission, the Federal Communications Commission, or the Department of State. **(as per Florida Statute Chapter 337.401, Use of right-of-way for utilities subject to regulation; permit; fees).**

The registrant must comply at all times with all policies and procedures of the City of Doral's code of ordinances.

3. A copy of the annual surety bond, cash deposit or irrevocable letter or credit in the sum of \$125,000.00 or in the amount of construction work of the previous calendar year within the City limits, whichever is greater of the two.

Certificate of Franchise Authority requirements:

1. The name of the certificate holder and its identification number.
2. A grant of authority to provide cable or video services as requested in the application.
3. A grant of authority to construct, maintain, and operate facilities through, upon, over, and under any public right-of-way or waters, subject to the applicable governmental permitting or authorization from the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund.
4. A statement that the grant of authority is subject to lawful operation of the cable or video service by the applicant or its successor in interest.
5. A statement that describes the service area for which this certificate of authority applies.
6. A statement that includes the issuance date that shall be the effective date of the commencement of this authority.
