### DORAL CENTRAL PARK CAMPGROUND RULES

Camping Under the Stars is an overnight family-friendly event designed to create a safe, fun, and memorable camping experience. Please review all information below carefully to ensure a smooth check-in and enjoyable stay.

#### EVENT ENTRY & CHECK-IN

Entrances along NW 87th Avenue will close at 2:00 PM in preparation for the event. At that time, the park will be closed to the public, with access remaining available to the Aquatic Center and Community Center only. **Event entry and check-in will begin at 4:00 PM.**

- Upon check-in, the adult identified as the **Responsible Party** of the group, and any adults 21 years or older, must present a **photo ID** before receiving wristbands and a tent number.
- All members of the group must be physically present at the check-in table with their Responsible Party to receive a wristband.
- The Responsible Party must remain with their group for the duration of the event.
- **One ticket = one tent with a maximum of 6 people.**
- Tent setup is not permitted before 4:00 PM.
- Check-in must be completed by **7:30 PM**. Tent setup will not be permitted once registration is closed.
- After tent setup, the tent number assigned must be displayed in a visible area outside the tent.
- **Campsites may only be set up after completing registration and receiving wristbands and a tent number.**

#### TENT & CAMPSITE GUIDELINES

- Tents may not exceed **10 ft x 14 ft** and are limited to 6 people per tent.
- Tents must be placed at least **4 feet apart** from neighboring tents.
- Each tent will be assigned a tent number. The number must be displayed in a visible area outside the tent at all times.
- Each campsite will be provided with four glow sticks, which should be placed on the tent corners or along the tent strings to maintain visibility after park lights are turned off.
- Park lights will be turned off at 11:00 PM. Attendees should expect limited visibility after this time.
- Vehicles are not permitted on the campsite at any time.
- Only properly registered participants are allowed to stay overnight.

## **PARKING INFORMATION**

- Parking is **free** and available on a **first-come, first-served** basis. Early arrival is encouraged.
- Parking is open to the public and is **not limited to registered campers**.
- When the main parking lot is full, guests will be directed to overflow parking.
- Unloading zones are available for campers to briefly unload tents and gear. Vehicles must be moved immediately after unloading.

## **OVERFLOW PARKING & FREE TROLLEY SERVICE**

Overflow parking will be available for guests when on-site parking reaches capacity. Campers who use overflow parking will have the opportunity to move their vehicles back to the park **before lights out at 11:00 PM**, as parking spaces become available.

Complimentary trolley service will be provided to and from the park on **Friday, February 6**, from **5:00 PM to 12:00 AM**.

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- For the comfort and safety of our patrons, domestic animals, including canines, felines, and other household pets, are not permitted at this facility. The provisions of this rule shall not apply to the use of a special needs service animal. Please refer to Section 29-38 of the City of Doral Code of Ordinances for more information.
- No alcoholic beverages or smoking.
- Generators are not permitted.
- Grills (gas or charcoal), individual fire pits, and BBQs are not permitted at the campsite.
- A community fire pit will be available for S'mores only. All other cooking over the fire pit is prohibited. Children near the campfire must be supervised at all times.
- Parents and guardians are responsible for supervising children at all times.
- Individuals under 21 years old may not camp overnight unless accompanied by an adult over the age of 25.
- **City staff reserves the right to remove individuals engaged in misconduct or noncompliance.**
- Please dispose of all trash in the proper containers during and after the event.

## CAMPFIRE & FOOD INFORMATION

### BOY SCOUTS TROOP 552 – S'MORES & BREAKFAST

The community fire pit will open Friday evening for S'mores only. Boy Scouts Troop 552 will be selling S'mores kits for **\$5**. No other food grilling or cooking will be permitted over the fire pit.

On Saturday morning, Boy Scouts Troop 552 will also offer a hot, cooked breakfast for purchase. Campers are encouraged to pack light and support their local Scouts.
